Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular, non-titling class created to demonstrate advanced training and handling skills on international style courses. The class aids in the selection process for World Team members. The rules are based on international competition. The course designs are diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the 'Challenge of the Day.' The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in the Excellent Class.

Eligibility of Dogs: Open only to dogs that are eligible to compete in both the Excellent Standard Class and the Excellent Jumpers With Weaves Class, Regular or Preferred. All American dogs are not eligible to compete in the International Sweepstakes.

Jump Heights: The ISC Class shall be split into three (3) separate categories; Mini Agility for dogs measuring 13-3/4" and/or less at the withers, Midi Agility for dogs measuring 16-7/8" at the withers and/or less, and Maxi Agility for dogs measuring greater than 16-7/8" at the withers. As indicated in the equipment specifications for the ISC Class, dogs entered in Mini Agility jump 14" in height, dogs entered in Midi Agility jump 18" in height, dogs entered in Maxi Agility jump 26" in height.

Obstacles: All regular obstacles are allowed plus the viaduct jump. Contact zones are 36". The A-frame is 5'6" for Mini and Midi dogs, and 5'7" for Maxi dogs. Table - sit, down or stand allowed.

Courses: There will be both a **Standard and a JWW** course with 18 to 20 obstacles.

Faults Outline: 5 point faults - knocked bar, fly off, contacts, anticipate table count, missed weave poles, incorrect pole entry, stepping on broad jump, refusal, run outs, exiting contact prior to descent. Time faults - leaving

table early. Elimination - 3 refusals and/or run outs, wrong courses, failure to complete all obstacles on course.

STD Course time: 2.75-3.50 YPS for Mini dogs, 3.00-3.75 YPS for Midi dogs and 3.50-4.25 YPS for Maxi dogs at the judge's discretion.

JWW Course time: 3.50-4.00 YPS for Mini dogs, 3.75-4.25 YPS for Midi dogs and 4.00-4.50 YPS for Maxi dogs at the judge's discretion.

Major International Sweepstakes Class Scores (ISC Class):

"Clean run" scores from the following ISC Classes at 14", 18" and 26" inches may be used to fulfil the minimum requirements of 8 Std/8 JWW requirements. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class. Two ISC jumpers and two ISC standard scores may be used to fulfil the minimum requirements.

ISC Combined Class Winners:

Combined scores from ISC Jumpers and Standard classes will be used to award the Combined ISC Class Award. Only Clean Run (no time or course faults) scores will be used to compute the Combined Score. The Combined Class winner from the 14, 18 and 26 inch height is invited to attend Team Tryouts. They do not need to fulfil the requirement of the 8/8 scores nor are they required to achieve the 4 double Q scores. The dog must have an approved pedigree and also fulfil any requirements for specific rabies shots or titering. The team must also send in all the required information including the dog's competition record with the fees and the entry form and meet all the other basic eligibility noted in this document. The handler at tryouts must be the same handler that won the combined award.

TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **THE SAFETY** of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- **FOREIGN EXHIBITORS** must pay be international money order or credit cards. Checks drawn on Canadian banks (US or Canadian funds) can no longer be accepted.
- TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.
- NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.
- NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.
- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- **ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, extreme weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.
- **JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS.** The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.
- **EVENT COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.
- BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".
- DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.
- **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE** will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
