SITE INFORMATION

This trial will be held outdoors at the Middlesex County 4-H Fairgrounds, rain or shine. Parking is free and there is ample crating space. Plenty of shade and water will be available. Restrooms are on the grounds. In addition, a wade pool and river are available. The courses will be run on 100' x 100' grass rings. No practicing in the rings is allowed at anytime. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

TRIAL REGULATIONS -- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **THE SAFETY** of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
