PLEASE NOTE – SET UP begins at 9am Thursday morning.

The club must set up before exhibitors can set up their crates. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Confirmation Information** Please verify all information emailed separately. If there are any discrepancies, please contact me as soon as possible so I can correct the situation.
- Jump Height Cards** This trial will NOT have an official measurer. Therefore, all dogs without an AKC Jump Height Card will need to be measured prior to judging. You must be measured by the judge for your class. Measuring will begin 30 minutes prior to the start of each class. This excludes 24" dogs.
- Food** There will be a food vendor onsite. There is an indoor eating area upstairs overlooking the crating/trial ring. No food or beverages (except water) on the artificial turf.
- Crating** All dogs crated inside the building must be in the designated area. **All crates must have mats underneath them to protect the floor.** Please conserve space when crating.
- Set Up** The grounds will be available for set up on Thursday 9am. On Fri-Sun, set up is 7am
- Parking** Please respect areas marked as "no parking" and "no exhibitor parking". We have very specific parking restrictions on Friday as the Field House is running business as usual – they need to have spaces for their clientele. Please park only on the paved areas. The first parking area (on the right) as you enter the property is for RVs only. The middle section is for Field House clientele. Our ability to use this facility in the future depends on your cooperation. The third (north) parking is open to anyone.
- RVs and Parking** There is limited RV parking which has been filled.
- ARMBANDS** Your armband will be available at the table with the courses. It is not included in this confirmation letter. Per the AKC all competitors must wear an armband when competing.
- VOLUNTEERS** Volunteers are the heart soul of agility trials. None of us can play without people to work in the ring when it's our turn to run with our dog. Please help out. We have drinks and snacks (and baked goods), lunch tickets and raffle tickets for you. Please sign up on line for your favorite position! The link is on my website! Directions to The Field House, 166 Athletic Drive, Shelburne, VT 05482

From CANADA, NH, MA, CT, ME and RI: Take Interstate I-89 to Interstate I-189 (exit 13). Follow I-189 approximately 2 miles to its termination. Turn left onto US Route 7 south (Shelburne Road) and follow south to the Village of Shelburne. At the traffic light in the center of the Village, turn right onto Harbor Road. After crossing the railroad tracks, turn right at the second street onto Athletic Drive. The Field House is approximately 6.5 miles from exit 13, I-89.

From New York State: Travel north on Interstate I-87 (The Northway) to Exit 20 (Queensbury). Turn left and follow the signs for Route 149 to Fort Ann. In the center of Fort Ann, turn left at the traffic light and drive north on U.S. Route 4 for about 19 miles to Route 22A in Vermont. Turn left on to Route 22A North and drive 40 miles thru Vergennes to its intersection with Route 7. Turn left on to US Route 7 north and drive to Shelburne. In the village turn left at the traffic light on to Harbor Road. After crossing the railroad tracks, turn right at the second street onto Athletic Drive. The Field House is approximately 6.5 miles from exit 13, I-89.
