# Have a Heart!

Eastern English Springer Spaniel club is having a TEAM Contest.

You must sign up before any of your team members run.

\*3 handlers to a team.\*

Each dog may only compete on one team. A handler may compete on more than one team BUT not twice on the same team.

For each Q, your team earns a heart.



The team with the most hearts wins. If there is a tie, the team with the highest total combined scores PLUS the greatest total combined full-seconds under Standard Course Time.

Scores will be used from the Jumpers with Weaves class on Saturday and from the Standard class on Sunday.

ROSETTES will be given to First Place Team, Second Place Team and Third Place Team....and also for the last place team !

So join in the fun...find some team mates and sign up!

There will be additional points earned based on surprise elements.

Hmm –doesn't that make you wonder???

You may email me by Monday Feb 9<sup>th</sup> with your team name, exhibitor name, dog name and classes entered or sign up first thing in the morning before the class begins!

## **How to earn EXTRA points even if you don't Q!!!**

- Wear Red
- Wear a heart
- Dress in the same colors as your dog
  - if you own a Dalmatian , wear black & white
  - if you own a black Lab, wear black
- Your dog wears a red collar
- Your team recites an original poem that begins with:
  - Roses are Red, Violets are Blue.....
- Each of your team members quacks like a duck on the start line, for both runs.

## **How many points will this get me????**

We will have 2 Valentines bags. One bag will have each of the above suggestions in it. The other bag will have points written on a piece of paper.

We will pull one suggestion (such as Wearing Red) from the first bag and then pull the number of points from the second bag. Points will vary from 10 pts to 100 pts! Each member of your team that participates in the above will earn that number of EXTRA points.

**Points will be awarded at the END of the contest.**
