<u>OBSTACLES</u>: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the *AKC Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEES: \$27.00 for the first entry of a dog; \$17.00 for the second entry of the same dog per day; \$13.00 for the third entry; \$13.00 for the fourth entry. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog per day for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. Separate checks must be sent for separate trials opening on the same day. Entries will be returned if check amounts are not made out properly.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Saturday, June 13, 2015 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit card.
- TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.
- NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.
- NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.
