### Rules to Enter:

- Dogs must be at least 1 year of age
- Dogs must compete in regulation jump height (or preferred height)
- Dogs do not need to be entered in the LEAP trial
- A jump height card is not required nor are dogs required to be measured

### **Exhibitor Rules:**

- Toys are allowed in the ring
- Food is NOT allowed in the ring
- Maximum course time of 75 seconds
- Handler must attempt to run the course; practicing just one piece of equipment is not allowed
- No harsh verbal or physical training allowed
- · Excusal for handler swearing in the ring
- Excusal for dog defecating or vomiting in the ring

### General Info:

- Classes offered: Novice, Open, and Excellent/Master Standard. Entries limited to 50 run for Novice, 50 for Open, and 100 for Excellent/Master.
- No scoring or ribbons/prizes offered.
- Match judging to follow approximately 30 minutes after conclusion of the LEAP trial on Friday.
- Pre-entered dogs will run first.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

### **Entry Fees:**

<u>Pre-entry</u>: \$10 for first entry of each dog; \$7 for the second run of the same dog; \$5 for the third entry. Pre-entries must be received by Monday, November 21, 2016, 6 p.m..

<u>Day-of-match entry</u>: *If space permits, day-of-match entries will be accepted until 12 p.m. on Friday.* \$11 for first entry; \$7 for the second and third entries of same dog.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the

### Julie Daniels -Stage IV Breast Cancer Immunotherapy Treatment in Germany.

When my breast cancer was diagnosed Stage IV, it was explained to me that my cancer is not a winnable fight. The standard of care for Stage IV breast cancer is chemotherapy for the rest of my life, which could be 10 years or more if 1 am lucky. I chose a different way, to fortify my own immune system as a force for cure, and 1 am in Germany receiving this treatment at a private clinic. This first course of treatment is for three months.
