ENTRY FEES: \$25.00 per dog per day for the first entry; \$20.00 for the second entry of the same dog each day; \$15.00 each for the third and fourth entry of the same dog. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog per day for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Entries close Saturday, January 28, 2017 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

After the close of entries, a processing fee of \$7.00 will be withheld from refunds for bitches entered in one class, \$11.00 for two classes, and \$15.00 for three classes. SITE INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors on rolled rubber matting. Parking is free. There is no RV parking at this site. No ex-pens allowed. No practicing in the rings is allowed at anytime. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

The AK9C dog park will be open. This fenced area is open to the general public.
