***** SITE INFORMATION*****

We are very fortunate to be allowed use of the Wide World of Sports. It is imperative that ALL exhibitors follow the guidelines and rules in order to maintain this facility.

- **All exhibitors must pick up after their dogs**
- **Do not allow your dogs to urinate on the building. This means paying close attention to your dogs at all times, especially while walking through door ways**
- **Absolutely no dogs will be allowed near the dome at the rear of the building for any purpose. Violators will be held accountable to the clubs and the AKC..**
- **No food or drink in the exhibitor area on the tarps. If coffee or anything is spilled, it will stain and will not be allowed to have dog shows.**
- **Please place mats under your crates to prevent leaks and tears.**
- **There are 2 areas to use for potty areas:**
 - **Directly in front of the building which is marked with signs**
 - **Down the hill to the large grassy area**
- **Confirmation Information** Please verify all information emailed . If there are any discrepancies, please contact me as soon as possible so I can correct the situation.
- **Jump Height Cards** This trial will have an official measurer (VMO). Therefore, all dogs without an AKC Jump Height Card will need to be measured prior to judging, including 24" dogs. Measuring will begin 30 minutes prior to the start of each class.
- **Food** There is a food concession on site. The "normal" fare is pizza, nachos, and hotdogs. No food/drinks (except water) are allowed on the soccer fields.
- **Set Up** You may set-up crates, etc on Friday afternoon between 4 and 6 PM. The building will be open on Saturday and Sunday mornings at 7 AM.
- **Crating** No personal chairs are allowed in the crating area. They may be used ringside in the marked areas. Xpens for multiple dogs only. Playpen type crates may not be twice the size of a crate. Please be considerate and if you are asked to move your crate, please cooperate.
- **Ring Side** Please do not sit within 5 feet of the ring gating. No dogs within 5 feet of the ring gating unless your dog is in line to run.
- **ARMBANDS** Armband labels are no longer required. Armband numbers are still assigned.
- **VOLUNTEERS** This year you can sign up for exactly the job you want!! Please use the online worker schedule. Go to my website, click on the tab for online workers and then fill in your name!! EASY as 1-2-3!! Questions –email Mike Lappin anidoc@comcast.net

There will be only one walk thru for NOVICE and OPEN

Excellent – 4-12 will walk as one group and run

16's will walk as one group and run

20-24's will walk/walk then all run. Split to be determined at gate.

FAST –X/M Fast will walk followed by a combined Open/Nov FAST walk. X/M FAST will run immediately following all walks, then Open FAST will run then Novice FAST will run.

Information regarding the Canine Flu

As most of you have heard the H3N2 canine flu is extremely contagious and was making the rounds of dog shows. Please take precautions if you are attending any dog show. Use hand sanitizer as frequently as possible. Before returning to your house, wash the soles of your shoes with a bleach solution. We, as agility exhibitors, are generally very friendly with all dogs at a trial. Consider washing your hands after being in contact with dogs other than your own. Some have said covering your crate also is beneficial. If the weather is nice, crate out of your car, if possible.

I have been asked if I know if any of the local agility trials have resulted in sick dogs. I have not been contacted by anyone saying their dog has the flu after attending a trial. That is not to say it hasn't or couldn't happen. You, as an owner, must make the best decision for your dog and household.

The club will have hand sanitizer conveniently available at each ring side, on the table with gate sheets and the volunteer table. They will also clean, at night, the entrance where the dogs enter. A mat will be laid down just inside the door so it may be properly cleansed.

The best prevention is to be informed. If your dog shows ANY signs, please be responsible and remove your dog from the trial as soon as possible. If your dog coughs at all during the week, please do not bring your dog to the trial. If you are unsure if that cough you heard is from the flu, ask yourself if your dog has ever coughed before? The majority of our dogs do not cough for any reason. If they cough, there is usually a reason.

We appreciate everyone being a responsible dog owner so that we may continue to have trials and enjoy dog sports.
