

AKC Sanctioned B Agility Match Friday, June 21, 2019 Wassamki Springs Campground 56 Saco Road Scarborough, MA 04074

Here's your chance to train in the ring! You can work on contacts, distance, weave poles or just introduce an inexperienced dog to the trial setting without the pressure of trying to qualify.

Rules to Enter:

- Dogs must be at least 1 year of age
- Dogs must compete in regulation jump height (or preferred height)
- Dogs do not need to be entered in the trial
- A jump height card is not required nor are dogs required to be measured

Exhibitor Rules:

- Toys are allowed in the ring
- Food is NOT allowed in the ring
- Maximum course time of 75 seconds
- Handler must attempt to run the course; practicing just one piece of equipment is not allowed
- No harsh verbal or physical training allowed
- Excusal for handler swearing in the ring
- Excusal for dog defecating or vomiting in the ring

General Info:

- Classes offered: Novice, Open, Excellent, and Master Standard.
- No scoring or ribbons/prizes offered.
- Match judging to follow approximately 30 minutes after conclusion of the trial.
- Pre-entered dogs will run first.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Entry Fees:

Entries open Tuesday, June 4, 2019 at 8 a.m. \$10 for the first entry of each dog. \$5 each for the second and third entries of same dog. *Pre-entries close on Monday, June 17, 2019 at 6 p.m.*

Day-of-match entries will be accepted until 2 p.m. on Friday, June 21: \$12 for the first entry each of each dog. \$7 each for the second and third entries of the same dog.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this doa.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom. sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running, If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?



Christine Tilburg will serve as evaluator and tester from 11 AM – 3 PM. It will be first come, first tested. Novice tests will be \$10, Advanced and Intermediate tests will be \$15. If you have a CGC you only need 5 tricks for Novice! If you don't that's OK – then it's just 10 tricks for Novice. Treats are allowed. Possible Novice tricks include: Puppy pushups, going through a tunnel, going over a jump, hand touch, pedestals....you have far more tricks than you even know! If you're going for Advanced bring your own props!
