Agility trials are an important part of the agility community. Exhibitors enjoy the camaraderie, friends, practicing new skills, and earning titles. Due to the Covid-19 virus pandemic, we have had to change many things in our daily lives, the same is true for agility. We have been planning, evaluating, and researching ways to safely hold agility trials. We will be complying with the Connecticut Governor's guidelines for opening the state and for gatherings. If trials cannot be held, we will notify all competitors by email before the closing and all checks received will be shredded.

TMAC wants exhibitors, workers, and judges to be in a safe environment. As a result, there will be changes to our trial format and we will be imposing new guidelines and restrictions.

1. The entry limit has changed to a limit of 45 handlers per trial. There will be 2 trials per day to maximize participation, while maintaining a safe environment.

2. <u>Crating</u>: Crating in Little Paws will be extremely limited to ensure safe distancing. There will be space available for outdoor crating (bring your own shade); or you can work from your car. Un-entered dogs will not be allowed in Little Paws crating area. Only 5 people will be allowed in the building at a time for set-up. All items must be removed from Little Paws when you leave after your runs on Saturday; even if you are running both days! The building will be sanitized overnight.

3. Additional parking will be available. See Trial Confirmation for details.

4. Anyone entering either building will need to wear a mask which will include the judge, all workers and ring crew. Exhibitors do not have to wear a mask when they run, but will be required to put their mask on before and after their run.

5. Exhibitors will maintain six-foot social distancing inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.

7. There will be no seating/viewing area and no chairs will be allowed in the main building.

8. A gate steward will be at the door directing you as to when to enter the building for walk-thrus and running your dog. A worker will open the entrance and exit gates for your run.

9. Only 3 or less exhibitors will be allowed in the building while they are in que for their runs. TMAC will provide additional shade outside for waiting and have audio set up so you can hear who is on deck.

10. Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will use a grabber to pick up and transport the leash, sanitizing after each dog.

11. Results will be posted outside the building. In addition, results will be emailed to the exhibitors following the trial weekend.

12. Course maps will be posted in multiple locations in and outside the building for exhibitors to take pictures. There will be paper course maps for those that choose, but please do not share!

13. There will not be food or beverages at the trial. Competitors will need to bring their own food and drinks.

14. Please do not bring MACH cakes or desserts to share with exhibitors.

15. Ribbons will not be self-serve. A worker will place stickers on them and have them available at a table outside of the building.

16. There will be plenty of soap and paper towels. Please wash your hands frequently. There will also be single use gloves available provided by TMAC. We will have a limited amount of hand sanitizer, therefore, we recommend you bring your own, as well as your own mask.

17. **ONLY** dogs who are entered in this trial will be measured; dogs will be measured by the VMO only. Please teach your dog to stand on a table with someone sitting by them to make it easy on dogs and VMO. If a dog is not compliant, they might not get measured for it would be impossible for the handler and the VMO to be 6 feet apart with a dog that is unsure about the process.

Briefings will be outside of the building, there will be no obsessive walk-throughs and walk-throughs will be limited to approximately 15 handlers or less.
Agility equipment that is touched, restrooms, doors, tables, chairs, etc. will be cleaned/sanitized throughout the day.

20. There will be ONE-WAY doors for both Little Paws and the Main Building, to help with the flow of traffic and keeping distance.

**By entering this trial, I agree to comply with all guidelines set in place by TMAC, Paws N Effect, the CDC, and federal, state, and local governments. I understand that I am voluntarily participating in this event entirely at my own risk and accept sole responsibility for my own health and safety.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes in the same trial and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred in the same trial.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW in the same trial.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial/trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial throughout of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per trial, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

• FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - \circ $\;$ Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

(Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

ENTRY FEES: MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. \$28.00 for the first entry of a dog in each trial; **\$21.00** for the second entry of the same dog in the same trial and **\$18.00** for the third entry in the same trial. Entry fees include the AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog, per trial for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in each trial. Please use a separate entry form for each trial.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Friday, July 24, 2020 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests must be received by the trial secretary no later than $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit card.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours. NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- **ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- **ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.
- JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- **DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.
- **EVENT COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

- **DOGS PARTICIPATING** must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to mixed breed dogs.
- **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE** will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.
