A rosette, jump bar, engraved tray, and neck ribbon will be awarded to all dogs earning an AGCH, MACH, PACH, or PAX.

A rosette will be awarded to any dog earning a Bronze, Silver, Gold, or Century title in the Master classes.

All dogs earning a title will receive a New Title rosette.

A ribbon will be awarded to any dog earning a Double Q.

ALL PRIZES, AWARDS, ROSETTES AND RIBBONS MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF THE TRIAL. NO PRIZES WILL BE MAILED.

SITE INFORMATION

Attention: For safety reasons, no vehicle traffic is permitted between the permanent building and the bubble. This includes parking, loading or unloading of any vehicle except for trial personnel moving equipment in and out of the facility.

This trial will be held at a large indoor sports complex inside a pressurized dome. The dome must be entered either through revolving doors or through a pressure lock - you enter through an outside door, the door is then closed, and the inside door is opened.

There is a permanent building that houses a swimming pool and a café that serves food adjacent to the dome. NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE PERMANENT BUILDING. There is ample parking, but it is a distance from the dome.

As always, everyone must pick up after their dogs and have them on leash while on the show premises. Exercise areas will be marked. Dogs are not permitted on the landscaped areas around the buildings.

MATS MUST BE PLACED UNDER ALL CRATES. No food or drinks other than water is permitted on the turf. Chairs will be allowed in the back crating area only. No chairs on the turf. Ex-pens and play pens will be allowed in the back crating area only.

No practicing in the rings is allowed at anytime. **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.**

TMAC's Northeast Agility Championship (Optional)

Purpose: Since the AKC Nationals were canceled in 2020 due to the pandemic, TMAC has decided to offer its own version of the Nationals on a smaller local scale. Our intent is to give competitors a "look and feel", similar to what they would experience had the event been held. For those that did not qualify for the nationals, this will give them some experience in sharing in the excitement. Please note, this is optional. You may enter classes as you would normally and choose not to compete in the Championship/Finals.

Who is eligible: Event is open to all teams eligible to compete in the Excellent/Masters Class for Standard and JWW.

Divisions: there will be 10 separate divisions based on jump heights. There will be 5 Regular jump heights (8, 12, 16, 20 & 24) and 5 Preferred jump heights (4, 8, 12, 16 & 20). The 24C class will NOT be offered in the TMAC Northeast Agility Championship.

How to Enter: If you wish to compete in TMAC's Northeast Agility Championship, you must be entered in the Standard, JWW, and Time to Beat classes for Saturday AND Premier JWW Sunday.

Those are the classes that will determine your score to qualify for the Finals. You may enter other classes as well, but only scores from those classes will count towards your eligibility for the finals.

Finals: The finals will be held after all classes have finished on Sunday. A rosette and bar will be awarded to the Winner in each height division.

Fees: The fees for the regular classes are stated in the premium. If you wish to compete for the Championship, please check the appropriate box. The additional fee is \$20 per dog.

What else do you need to know: *This trial will run as a normal trial. Enter this trial even if you have no aspirations of competing in the Championship.* The Championship is only for those people who choose to enter. Everyone in a class will run together. If there are 30 teams in a height/class, perhaps only 10 of those teams are entered in the Championship. The class will function as it normally would. The only difference is that the scores for the 10 teams that opted to be in the Championship will serve a dual purpose in that they will also be used in qualifying for the Finals.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

As of January 1, 2020, For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only allowed in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. FEO will be of value to new exhibitors or exhibitors that are having difficulty with a specific obstacle and/or ring environment. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run

and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

(Note: This section only needs to be published in the Premium List if the Club is offering FEO.)

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trial.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the *AKC Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEE: MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. **\$27.00** for the first entry of a dog each day, **\$20.00** for the second entry of the same dog each day; **\$17.00** for the third entry, **\$16.00** for the fourth entry, and **\$15.00** for the fifth and sixth entries of the same dog each day. **ENTRY FEE FOR NORTHEAST AGILITY CHAMPIONSHIP IS \$20.00.** Fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog per day for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. **FOR MULTIPLE PAWPRINT TRIALS EVENTS OPENING ON THE SAME DATE, PLEASE SEND A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH PREMIUM LIST.**

CLOSING DATE: **Saturday, November 7, 2020 at 6 p.m.,** after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests, along with the veterinarian's note, must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

MIXED BREEDS: All owners of mixed breed dogs must obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC agility event. Under "Breed" on the entry form, dogs must be listed as "All American" and not as a breed hybrid.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit card.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO ONLINE ENTRIES.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

Agility trials are an important part of the agility community. Exhibitors enjoy the camaraderie, friends, practicing new skills, and earning titles. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, we have had to change many things in our daily lives, the same is true for agility. We have been planning, evaluating, and researching ways to safely hold agility trials. We will be complying with the Connecticut Governor's guidelines for opening the state and for gatherings. If trials cannot be held, we will notify all competitors by email before the closing and all checks received will be shredded. TMAC wants exhibitors, workers, and judges to be in a safe environment. As a result, there will be changes to our trial format and we will be imposing new guidelines and restrictions.

1. **Crating:** There will be 2 areas for Crating in the Soccer Dome. One will be to the left as you walk in o the dome. The other will be on the far left towards the basketball courts. Please spread out keeping 6 feet between you and someone else's crate. We will mark the area to help you with the six-foot requirement. You are also free to work out of your car.
2. Everyone entering either Dome or the rectangular building will need to wear a mask which will include the judges, all workers, and the ring crew. Exhibitors must wear a mask while running. Exceptions will be made for those with a doctor's note. When you are inside the dome, and not running a dog, you need to be wearing your mask.
3. Exhibitors will maintain six-foot social distancing inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
4. There will be no bleacher seating in the dome. You may bring your own chairs and maintain the six-foot social distancing requirement.
5. While waiting in line to enter the ring, please use the track area and maintain a six-foot distance with other competitors. We will mark the area to help with this. A worker will open the entrance and exit gates for your run.
6. Handlers may place their leash in their pocket or wear them while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash as the start, a leash runner will use a grabber to pick up and transport the leash.

7. Results will be posted in the building. In addition, results will be emailed to the exhibitors following the trial weekend.

8.. Course maps will be posted in multiple locations in the building for exhibitors to take pictures. There will be paper course maps for those that choose, but please do not share !

9. TMAC will NOT provide any food or beverages at the trial. Competitors will need to bring their own food and drinks, or purchase from the concessions at the facility.

10. Please do NOT bring MACH cakes or desserts to share with exhibitors.

11. Ribbons will not be self-serve. A worker will place stickers on them and have them available at a table in the Dome.

12. Please wash your hands frequently. There will also be single use gloves available provided by TMAC. We will have a limited amount of hand sanitizer, therefore, we recommend you bring your own, as well as your own mask.

If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only.
