The Talcott Mountain Agility Club (TMAC) wants exhibitors, workers, and judges to participate in a safe environment. The club will comply with the Connecticut Governor's guidelines for opening the state and for gatherings. If trials cannot be held, the club will notify all competitors by email before closing; all received checks will be shredded.

TMAC has instituted certain changes to its trial format and imposed new guidelines and restrictions to ensure everyone's safety:

- 1. In order to limit the number of onsite exhibitors, the class order and heights are being structured so that all 4"-16" Ex/Ma and Premier entries will compete on Saturday, February 27, and all 16P"-24" Ex/Ma and Premier entries will compete on Sunday, February 28. Novice Std and Open Std (all heights) will compete on Saturday; Novice JWW and Open JWW (all heights) will compete on Sunday. Entries are limited to 220 runs per day.
- 2. Crating space will be limited and appropriately spaced to ensure distancing and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis; you may alternately work from your vehicle. Un-entered dogs will not be permitted in the crating area. Novice and Open classes will compete at the beginning of each day so that exhibitors may compete, retrieve their belongings and depart to make room for Ex/Ma and Premier exhibitors during the remainder of each day. All items must be removed from the crating area at the end of each day so the site can be sanitized overnight.
- 3. One-way doors will be designated for access to both the main building and crating area to aid traffic flow and distancing.
- 4. Everyone on-premises, both inside and outside the building, must wear a mask at all times unless you are sitting inside your vehicle. Exhibitors must wear a mask while competing, with no exceptions. You must bring your own mask; however, a limited supply is available if your mask should break or be misplaced. See the trail chair or co-chair to request a new mask.
- 5. Exhibitors should maintain six-foot social distancing while inside and outside the building. Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors.
- 6. Food and beverages will not be offered at the trial. Exhibitors should plan to bring any food or drink they wish to have during the day. Please do not bring MACH cakes or desserts to share with exhibitors.
- 7. Cleaning supplies and sanitizer will be provided onsite; please wash and sanitize your hands frequently. Single-use gloves will be used at all times by workers who are moving equipment, working as ring crew, or other contact-based roles.
- 8. Agility equipment that is touched, restrooms, doors, tables, chairs, etc., will be cleaned/sanitized throughout the day.

- 9. Only dogs entered in this trial may be measured, and by the VMO only. Be sure to train your dog to stand on a table with someone sitting by them. If a dog is not compliant, it may not be possible to complete a measurement.
- A limited quantity of paper course maps will be available onsite. The trial secretary may post the course maps online the evening before each day. Maps will be posted onsite at the beginning of each day, both outside the main building and in the indoor crating area, for exhibitors to take pictures.
- 11. A seating/viewing area will not be available in the main room; chairs will not be allowed in the main building except for individuals in designated roles. Exhibitors may bring personal chairs to the crating area. An area will be designated to accommodate capturing video, with no more than three videographers permitted at a time.
- 12. Briefings will be held outside of the building, weather permitting. If conditions do not permit an outdoor briefing, separate, small-group briefings may be conducted in the main building or in writing. Walk-throughs will be limited to approximately twenty or fewer handlers.
- 13. Five or fewer teams will be allowed in the building to queue up for runs. A gate steward will be stationed at the entrance to direct exhibitors when to enter the building for walk-thrus and classes.
- 14. Handlers may place their leash in a pocket or wear it on their person while running the course. If handlers elect to drop their leash at the start, a leash runner will use a grabbing tool or gloved hand to pick up and transport the leash to the leash chair, sanitizing the grabber/glove after each leash.
- 15. Results will be posted near the crating area and emailed to exhibitors following the trial weekend.
- 16. Ribbons will not be self-serve. A worker will place stickers on ribbons for exhibitors to retrieve at a table outside of the building.

By entering this trial, I agree to comply with all guidelines set in place by TMAC, Paws N Effect, the CDC, and federal, state, and local governments. I understand that I am voluntarily participating in this event entirely at my own risk and accept sole responsibility for my own health and safety.

CLASS CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2020

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day:

Exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. For example, the same dog may now be entered in Regular FAST and/or T2B to finish up those titles while also entered in Preferred Master STD/JWW to start working towards their PACH at the lower height. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed.

Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers with Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO):

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. Competitors must enter in T2B and/or FAST. Participation in FEO is nonqualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run

and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring
 - Toys must be non-audible
 - o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
 - \circ $\;$ Toys that roll freely cannot be used
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG):

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

<u>OBSTACLES</u>: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

ENTRY FEES: MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. \$27.00 for the first entry of a dog in each trial; **\$20.00** for the second entry of the same dog in the each trial; **\$18.00** for the third entry. Entry fees include the AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog, per trial for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog in each trial. Please use a separate entry form for each trial.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Saturday, February 20, 2021 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

<u>REFUNDS</u>: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests must be received by the trial secretary no later than $\frac{1}{2}$ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit card.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours. NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.
- **ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- **ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS**-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.
- JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- **DOGS PRESENT** will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.
- **EVENT COMMITTEE** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

- **DOGS PARTICIPATING** must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to mixed breed dogs.
- ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
