There will also be live stream available [The Fieldhouse - Northford, CT \(fieldhouseagility.com\)](#) Premier course maps will be posted on my website the night before the trial by 9pm. ISC maps cannot be posted prior to the course being built.

Anyone showing a vaccination card will get a wrist band. Masks are optional for vaccinated people while running and as long as they maintain social distancing from others.

Anyone not vaccinated must wear a mask at all times, including while running.

This trial will be using Agility Gate! Please download the app on your phone or tablet. The code to sign in for this weekend will be 0703 . You can check in using Agility Gate and view the most current running order at any time. ### **Confirmation Information**

- Please verify all information at the bottom of this email. If there are any discrepancies, please contact me as soon as possible so I can correct the situation.

### **Jump Height Cards**

- This trial will have an official measurer. If you need to get your dog measured, please arrive a few minutes earlier than normal to get measured. This includes 24" dogs.

### **Site Info**

- You are allowed to walk your dog through the lobby but dogs may not stay for any extended time. Exhibitors may eat in the lobby. Restrooms are located to the right, as you enter the lobby from outside.

### **Maps**

- There will be no paper copies for maps. They will be NOT be posted online due to ISC rules.

### **Set Up**

- Exhibitors can set up any time after 7:00am Saturday morning.

### **Site info**

- No dogs are allowed in the lobby.
- If you show proof of vaccination, you will receive an arm-band so you don't have to wear a mask as long as you maintain social distancing.
- If you cannot show proof of vaccination, you will be required to wear a mask at all times, including in the

ring.

- Restrooms are located to the right, as you enter the lobby from outside.

## **Parking**

- Please take the time to park appropriately and straight. Please do not take up multiple spots with one vehicle.

## **Entrance and Exit**

- To enter/exit with your dog, use the door on the left side. Crating is immediately inside the door.

## **Crating**

- Please refer to the Indoor layout diagram (on my website) regarding crating.
- Crating will be in rows with a center aisle to allow for walking.
- X-pens will be limited to 8 panels, for 3 or more dogs. No multiple X-pen setups. Puppy Play Pens may be limited to 2 or more dogs.
- LOUNGE CHAIRS and TABLES will not be allowed, and we ask that you stack crates whenever possible. There will be no 'preferred' crating.
- Please be respectful of the trial committee if you are asked to move your setup to make room for others.
- Crate-aggressive dogs must be covered and may not be positioned on the corners of aisle ways or other heavy traffic areas. This will be enforced and if complaints are received, dogs will be moved.

## **Food**

- There is no food or water available to purchase. There will be no eating allowed inside the building due to Covid. You are required to wear your mask at all times inside the building. Beverages are allowed by briefly lowering your mask. Due to Covid, you may not leave your mask down for any period of time.

## **VOLUNTEERS**

- Please volunteer. Training and competing are only part of the sport. Volunteering is a key part of the sport.

## **Directions to The Field House, 15 Augur Rd, Northford, CT**

FROM RT. 91 SOUTH: Take Exit 14 for East Center Street toward CT-150/Wallingford. Turn left on East Center Street. Turn right onto Northford Road and continue onto Woods Hill Road. Turn right onto CT-17 South. Continue onto CT-22 East. Turn right on Augur Road.

FROM RT. 91 NORTH: Take Exit 9 for Montowese Avenue. Turn right on Montowese Avenue. Take slight left on Middletown Avenue. Turn right onto Half Mile Road and continue onto Augur Road Extension. Turn left on Totoket Road. Turn right on Augur Road.
