INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC) CUP

Purpose: The ISC class is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course design is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the “Challenge of the Day” when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent/Master classes. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website www.akc.org.

Course Designer: Stefanie Semkat, Germany

Eligibility: The Cup is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. Dogs may be entered in their Regular or Preferred jump height. However, there is no Preferred option for ISC; dogs entering in the Preferred jump height will be scored against their respective regular jump heights peers.

FCI/ISC cutoff heights:

- Small (12” jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 ¾” or less at the withers
- Medium (16” jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 ¾” and up to 16 7/8” at the withers
- Large (24” jump height) – for dogs measuring over 16 7/8” at the withers

Qualifications: “Clean run” scores from this ISC cup at the 12”, 16”, and 24” may be used toward fulfilling the minimum requirements for WTT/EOTT. A “Clean run” consist of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class.

This Cup is not a Regional World Team Qualifying event, meaning there will NOT be an automatic invite of the combined winners to WTT.

To be eligible for the overall placement awards, dogs must be entered and run in all four rounds. The lowest cumulative score for all four rounds will determine the winner in each height group.

Podium placements and awards will be announced once scores are tallied at the completion of all four runs.

For overall cup placements, dogs will be ranked in each round based on time-plus-faults scoring, as follows:

- Faults will be scored as 5 points (missed contacts, dropped bars, etc.).
Time faults will earn 3 faults per second over SCT.

INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC) CUP (continued)

- Elimination (E) will be scored as SCT plus 100 faults. Eliminations (E) will be earned for the following:
 - Incurring three faults (time faults exempt).
 - A wrong course (W).
 - Excusal (whistled off).
- Refusals/runouts (R) will be called but NOT scored for cup placement rankings (0 faults).

Fault examples (SCT = 55s):

- Dog #1 has two R’s and an F with a time of 35.01. Their score for that run will be 40.01.
- Dog #2 has one F and a W. Their score is 155 for that run.
- Dog #3 has a clean run, but their time is 58.5 seconds on a 55-second course. Their score is 67.5 for that run.

All winners will be announced at the completion of the four runs and when scores are tallied.

Obstacles: All regular obstacles allowed, plus the viaduct jump. There will be no table in the standard runs. A-Frame height will be the same as at a regular AKC trial heights.

Courses: The Cup will consist of 4 runs: 2 Standard and 2 Jumpers with Weaves runs.

Fix and Go On (FNG): FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog’s performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

SITE INFORMATION

A premiere, state-of-the-art facility dedicated to serving the dog agility community which is located in the south-central Connecticut town of Northford. The Fieldhouse sits just a few minutes from the I -91, Merritt/Wilbur Cross and I -95 corridor, located for exhibitors from all over New England and tri-state areas. It has wall to wall (23,000 sq ft) of synthetic turf with 100% virgin rubber infill along with year-round climate control including heat. It includes top brand agility equipment to furnish the ring: - Clip and Go, Galican, MAD Agility. Spacious entry hall with restrooms, gallery and seating areas, along with plenty of crating. HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trial. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the *AKC Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEES: MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. Entry fee is \$25.00 per run. **FOR MULTIPLE PAWPRINT TRIALS EVENTS OPENING ON THE SAME DATE, PLEASE SEND A SEPARATE CHECK FOR EACH PREMIUM LIST.**

CLOSING DATE: Entries close **Friday, June 25, 2021 at 6 p.m.**, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

CANCELLATIONS: In order for cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. **If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.** No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests must include a veterinarian's note and be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

MIXED BREED DOGS: All owners of mixed breed dogs must obtain an AKC Canine Partners Listing number before entering an AKC agility event. **Under "BREED" on the entry form, dogs must be listed as All American Dog and not as a breed hybrid.**

TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit cards. Checks drawn on Canadian banks (US or Canadian funds) can no longer be accepted.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, extreme weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
