• This trial will not have an official measurer. Therefore, any dog that is on the to be measured list will not need to be measured due to current Covid guidelines.

Mask and Waivers

• Per the club, all exhibitors and spectators will need to present vaccination cards in order to remain unmasked. If you cannot present a vaccination card, masks will be required at all times when in the building. Please present your card and completed waiver upon arrival, prior to entering the building. After your waiver and proof of vaccination is received, you will be given a wristband to wear. If your wristband is lost, you will need to present your vaccination card again. The ISAA strongly encourages even those who have been vaccinated to follow CDC guidance and to wear masks when inside buildings and in close proximity to others. Prior-Day Check-In

FROM THE SOUTH (Boston): I-93 North to Manchester I-293 to 101 West. Follow signs towards 101 West (Bedford - Milford). (AK9C is on the right, across from Camp Road at the blinking yellow light.)
