Start Time

- We are full with 30 entries in the Northeast Rally Cup. The entries for Obedience and Rally are large. All Obedience and Rally, including the Rally Cup will be held in the Young Building.
- The estimated time to start is 6pm. Please arrive by 5:30pm to check in.
- We will build the course as soon as regular judging has finished. Walk thrus will be allowed as soon as the course has been built.
- Running order will be little to big.
- We encourage everyone to enter and exit the ring quickly and efficiently to keep things moving

Northeast Rally Cup Rules

- There will be 30 signs with a mixture of Advanced, Excellent and Masters levels.
- Maximum course time is 6 minutes. If you have not completed the course in 6 minutes, you will lose 10 points for each missed station but cannot NQ.
- This will be scored like a Masters level course in that no retries are allowed.
- Max200 has donated electronic timing to ensure the most accurate time for your run.

Maps

- There will be paper maps available for each day. Maps will also be posted on my website on November 23, 2022. They will be posted under trials that are closed/Wyndham Rally.

Directions to Eastern States Exposition, Big E Gate 9 Parking Lot, West Springfield, MA

Gate 9 will be open during show hours. Please use Gate 1 (open 24 hrs.) if Gate 9 is closed.

FROM THE NORTH via I-91: Take I-91 South to Exit 10B, to Rte. 5 South, to Rte. 147 West. Follow Rt. 147 West for approximately 3/4 mile to The Big E Gate 9 entrance on the left.

FROM THE SOUTH via I-91: Take Exit 3 South marked "Route 5, Columbus Ave., Agawam, West Springfield". Follow Route 5 North to Route 147 West for approximately 3/4 mile to The Big E Gate 9 entrance on the left.

FROM THE MASS PIKE I-90: Take Exit 45. Follow signs marked "Route 5, Riverdale St., West Springfield". Take Route 5 South to Route 147 West for approximately 3/4 mile to The Big E Gate 9 entrance on the left.
