Run Order

- Due to the volume of Novice dogs, we have split the classes so the rings have equal numbers.
 - Novice 16-24 will run in Ring 1
 - o Open runs will run in Ring 2
 - X/M 4-8 will run in Ring 3 followed by Novice 4-12 *with only 6 weaves.
 - ∘ X/M 12-24 will run in Ring 4
- Rings will be open for walk thru as soon as they are built.
- The run order will be posted prior to the match

Match rules and guidelines

- Food is not allowed in the ring.
- Toys are allowed and encouraged. They may be thrown as a reward for obstacle performance. Exhibitors may not go in the ring and just throw a toy around to play with the dog.
- Obstacles may be repeated as many times as necessary.
- No harsh verbal or physical corrections.
- Handlers will be excused for swearing in the ring

Time Allotted in the Ring

- Maximum course time is 65 seconds. When you hear the whistle please move quickly to the exit.
- If you are the only dog in your jump height and have entered more than 1 run, your run time will be combined for all runs.
