- If you are entered in the Northeast Agility Championship (NAC), you will receive a separate email later this week with specific information for this special event!

Jump Height Cards

- We will have official measuring for our trial. If your confirmation information states "Needs to be Measured", your dog must be measured by a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) before he/she can run. One measurement is needed for all dogs competing between the ages of 15 months to 2 years. The yellow copy of the form will be your only proof of measurement. At 2 years old, dogs will need to be measured twice by two different VMO's. The AKC will send out a permanent height card after they have received both measurements. Measuring will occur throughout the day Friday, Saturday, Sunday and Monday.

Fees for Parking

- Parking fees are \$5 per day per car, \$40 per day per trailer/RV. Spaces are first come, first served. The east side of the building is open to RV parking for all exhibitors along with the other areas around the grounds.

Team Competition

- We still need a few folks to complete some teams! [Choose or create a team](#). Only teams that are not full will appear. Come on...it's fun...and it's a chance to meet some other exhibitors! Scores from Standard and JWW will be used to determine winners. All levels count (Nov,Op,X/M, Pref). There are four dogs per team. Maximum 2 dogs per handler per team. All teams must sign up online by Friday, November 24th . Scores will automatically be tabulated. Rosettes will be awarded for First, Second, and Third place teams!

Zero Tolerance

In the past, the Eastern States Exposition (ESE) has had several problems with dog-related events. As a result, the Thanksgiving Agility Cluster has adopted a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY regarding the show grounds and hotels. Show grounds are difficult to come by. It is your responsibility to treat the grounds with respect. It is also everyone's responsibility to report anyone not adhering to these guidelines.

Grounds for excusal for the remainder of the weekend:

- Any exhibitor who does not pick up after their dog
- Any exhibitor who tampers with ESE property. This includes building doors, electrical plugs, bathing of dogs, etc.
- Any exhibitor who leaves a barking dog in a hotel room
- Any exhibitor who leaves the conditions of the hotel room unacceptable
- Refusal to abide by any request from the show committee or staff of the ESE
- Refusal to abide by any posted signs
- Any exhibitor who allows their dog off leash except while in the ring or in the training area

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

Due to the volume of information we will be sending you regarding the Cluster, we felt it would be best to break it into multiple emails. Please review your classes and email me as soon as possible with corrections. You may process all Move-Ups online by clicking MY ENTRIES/MOVEUP.

If you need to move your dog up, please click on My Entries/MOVE UP on my website and move to the appropriate class. [Deadline for Move-Ups is Monday, November 20st, 6pm, per AKC.](#) You may not move up online, during the trial. You must complete a Move-Up form and hand it in to the scoring table.

We would like you to take advantage of all the technological opportunities that we are offering. It will provide a safer and more efficient trial, which is especially important in today's environment.

Text Alerts

- To receive Text Alerts, go to <https://my.pawprinttrials.com/profile/viewalerts>. After you have completed the process of signing up, go back to ALERTS and enable your preferred ALERTS. Prior Day Check-In and Run Results will be helpful for the Cluster.

Prior-Day Check-In

- Prior-Day Check-In will help ease the morning rush to check-in and alleviate crowding around the gate sheets. You may check in the day before the trial online by clicking Prior-Day Check-In at the top of my website. Prior-Day Check-In will only show the day before the trial and is available from noon -7pm only. After 7pm, this feature will be shut off to allow us to print gate sheets for the next day. You can receive a text alert, at noon, as a reminder to check-in. You may enable this feature under ALERTS.

Real-Time Run-Order

- Real-Time Run-Order will be in use for this trial. Click on Run-Order at the top of my screen each day. Each ring will be displayed with a list of exhibitors and a time of their run. The run order will update every few minutes. This will allow you to plan when you will be in the ring with your dog. You will be able to view it if you are in another building, your car or still at home! Note: a published run order will still be posted a few days before the trial, under the Cluster. The published run order is only an estimate of run times and running order of exhibitors. The **Real-Time Run-Order** is on the front page of my site and will be updated continually throughout the day.

Team Competition

- We have set a record for team competition -89 Teams which means over 350 people will be participating in a team. If you have not yet signed up for a team, [Click here to choose or create a team](#). Scores from Standard and JWW will be used to determine winners. All levels count (Nov,Op,X/M, Pref). There are four dogs per team. Maximum 2 dogs per handler per team. All teams must sign up online by Friday, November 24th
- We will redistribute any teams that are not full to complete full teams.

- Results will be posted mid day on my website and at the trial.
- Scores will automatically be tabulated. Rosettes will be awarded for First, Second, and Third place teams!

Versatility

- If your dog has earned a title in another AKC recognized sport click [your dog's name and OTHER SPORTS](#) Select a sport and click "Add". Qualifying scores from Standard and JWW will be used to determine the winner. We will automatically calculate the highest scoring dog with the required title. Exhibitors must sign up by Thursday, November 23rd. The winner in each category will receive a rosette! For a full list of sports and which days apply, view Versatility under the Cluster information on my site.

Results Matter

- All results will be posted on my website at the end of the day. You may also access results by clicking on your dog's name in your record/results OR by clicking on My Entries/Results. Results will be posted throughout the day. You can get a text alert with your results sent directly to your phone, by the end of each class. Sign up for Run Result by enabling this feature under Alerts.
