THE NORTHEAST AGILITY CHAMPIONSHIP (Optional)

Purpose: To give our competitors at the Cluster the "look and feel" of what it is like to compete at the Nationals, we are offering our own version of the Nationals. Whether you have qualified for the Nationals or not, you may compete in our Northeast Agility Championship. PLEASE NOTE, THIS IS OPTIONAL. You may enter classes as you would normally and choose not to enter the Championship/Finals.

Who is eligible: Event is open to all teams eligible to compete in the Excellent and Master Class for Standard and JWW.

Divisions: There will be 10 separate divisions based on jump heights. There will be 5 Regular jump heights (8, 12, 16, 20, and 24) and 5 Preferred jump heights (4, 8, 12, 16, and 20). The 24C class will NOT be offered. There must be at least 4 dogs entered in each Preferred division or that division will be combined with the "Regular" height. (ex. 8P will compete with 12" dogs if there are not at least four dogs entered in the 8P class)

How to Enter: If you wish to compete in The Northeast Agility Championship, you must be entered in the Standard, JWW, and Time to Beat classes for Friday AND Premier Standard on Saturday.

Those are the classes that will determine your score to qualify for the Finals. You may enter other classes as well, but only scores from those classes will count towards your eligibility for the finals.

Jr. Handlers: Cumulative overall winners from each scored jump height (4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24) will be invited to compete in the Finals. If a junior entrant competes in the Finals round, an additional Finals entrant will be added as if the Junior entrant was not included.

Finals: The Finals will be held after all classes have finished on Saturday. A special prize will be awarded to the winner in each division with rosettes for the top 3 finalists.

Fees: The fees for the regular classes are stated in the premium. If you wish to compete for the Championship, please check the appropriate box.

What else do you need to know: This trial will run as a normal trial. You may enter this trial even if you have no aspirations of competing in the Championship. The Championship is only for those exhibitors who choose to enter. For example, there may be 30 dogs in a height/class; of those 30 dogs, perhaps only 10 are entered in the Championship. The class will function as it normally would. The only difference is that the scores for the 10 dogs entered in the Championship will serve a dual purpose in that they will also be used in qualifying for the Finals.

Description and Scoring

The competition will consist of:

Friday, November 22
Round 1 – Standard Class

Saturday, November 23
Round 4 – Premier STD

(Challenger)

Round 2 – JWW Class Round 5 – Finals

Round 3 – Time 2 Beat (Hybrid)

Scores for Friday will be the aggregate scores from Rounds 1, 2 and 3. The top scoring 25% of teams entered in the Championship in each division, minimum of 4 teams (if possible) and not to exceed 9 teams, will advance to the Finals on Saturday. Of the next top 5 scoring teams from Friday, we will take the top scoring team in each division from Saturday's Premier Standard class and place them in the finals. In the event there are less than 4 dogs entered in the Preferred division in a class, those dogs will compete with dogs at the "regular" height (8P will compete with 12 Reg).

AKC agility Master rules will apply for <u>the qualifying rounds</u> with the following exceptions:

 Course Faults: A refusal (excluding T2B), runout, wrong course, missed contact and dropped bar will result in a 5-point deduction. Any run with an Excusal (E) will result in a score of zero. Course time deductions equal 3 points for every second over course time, truncating down to whole seconds.

For the Finals only:

- Course Faults: A refusal, runout, wrong course, missed contact, and dropped bar will result in a 5-point deduction. Not completing or skipping an obstacle will be signaled with a short whistle (you may complete the course). Score will be zero (no score).
- All obstacles must be completed or a score of zero will be assessed.
- You must have a score above zero to win any prize/ribbon in the Championship Finals.

For entry in the Finals, any ties from Friday will be broken based on times. Time 2 Beat times will be used as the first tiebreaker. The Regular JWW class times will be used as the second tie breaker, and the times from the Standard Class will be used next.

Ties from the Premier Standard class on Saturday will be broken based on time. If there is still a tie, we will use the aggregate scores from Friday's round, and then using the tie-breaker logic for Saturday.

Dogs will run in reverse order of placement in the Finals, with the winner of the Premier (Challenger) Class running first.

Note: Scores from the Finals will not count towards any AKC titles. All other issues will be resolved by the Championship Committee.

ALLISON VICUNA SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

This award will be presented annually at the Thanksgiving Cluster to the person selected by the committee.

<u>MOVEUPS & CANCELLATIONS</u>: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests, along with the veterinarian's note, must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. In the case of serious illness or injury to a dog, any refund requests accompanied by veterinary documentation will be reviewed by the committee. If a refund is granted, it will be 50 percent of the entry fees.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION TO ENSURE THEIR DOGS ARE FREE OF INTERNAL AND EXTERNAL PARASITES, ANY COMMUNICABLE DISEASES, AND HAVE APPROPRIATE VACCINATIONS.

ALL-AMERICAN DOGS: Owners of All-American dogs must obtain an AKC Canine Partners listing number before they may enter an AKC agility event.

UNDER "BREED" ON THE ENTRY FORM, DOGS MUST BE LISTED AS "ALL AMERICAN" AND NOT AS A BREED HYBRID.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) – EFFECTIVE 7/1/24

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club.
 FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment.
 FEO is allowed in all classes at this trial.
 Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may also be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL

From the North via Interstate 91: Take I-91 South to Exit 10B. Follow Route 5 South to Route 147 West. Continue 3/4 mile to show grounds on left

From the South via Interstate 91: Take I-91 North to Exit 3. Follow Route 5 North to Route 147 West, Memorial Avenue. ¾ mile to show grounds on left.

From Mass Pike I-90: Take Exit 44 (old Exit 4) to Route 5 South. Follow to Route 147 West. Continue on Memorial Avenue for ¾ mile to show grounds on left.

The Mallary Building is the large domed building on the left when entering through Gate 9.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Hotels that accept dogs are quickly becoming a rarity. Please behave responsibly! Clean up after your dog, bring sheets to cover the furniture, do not groom or bathe your dog inside, do not leave your dog(s) unattended in the room, and please be respectful of other guests who do not have to be up early. The trial committee will follow up on complaints received from motels. PLEASE CONFIRM HOTEL PET POLICIES WHEN MAKING RESERVATIONS.

MOTORHOME PARKING

There will be space for overnight parking of motorhomes and campers. The fee is \$40.00 per unit/per day and is collected by Eastern States personnel. No advanced reservations. The Clubs have no involvement in collecting fees and receive no portion of those fees.

Electrical hookups are located throughout the fairgrounds. Although there is ample RV parking, the clubs do not guarantee availability. Standard electrical service around the Mallary Building and Better Living Center is 30 amps. Overloading the circuits will result in tripped breakers. *Restoring service may not be immediate*, *especially at night*. 50 amp service is available for an additional fee.

Motorhomes and campers may move onto the grounds no earlier than two days prior to the start of the shows. You will be directed to the available lots for the shows. Certain areas of the grounds may be restricted. Storage and/or stock trucks may occupy the same space provided the same power source is utilized. Vehicles may not occupy a camper space in the designated camper lots. Gate 9 is open during show hours. Gate 1 near the Agawam bridge is open 24 hrs.

Overnight parking fee is \$40.00 per unit/per day. Reservations are available upon entrance to the grounds. Multiple reservations and saving of spaces are not permitted. 50 amp electrical service is available for an additional fee.

A dump station is available on the grounds at no charge. Please see a show official for its location. Please leave your parking areas clean by bagging all refuse and throwaway items.

IN ORDER TO PREVENT ADDITIONAL INCREASES in parking fees and SEVERE RESTRICTIONS on motorhome parking, PLEASE RESPECT Eastern States personnel, grounds and equipment.

SITE INFORMATION

This trial is held in conjunction with the Thanksgiving Cluster All-Breed Dog Shows and Obedience Trials. **Go to www.infodog.com** for conformation, obedience, and rally entry information.

No smoking in any buildings. Vendors must adhere to the West Springfield Fire Department regulations.

The courses will be run inside on 100' x 100' packed dirt rings. Crating space is available inside the building. No practicing in the rings is allowed at any time. The building will be closed at night. No dogs may remain in the building overnight.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.

TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay by international money order or credit cards. Checks drawn on Canadian banks (US or Canadian funds) can no longer be accepted.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, extreme weather, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

IN CASE OF CANCELLATION, call AKC Event Cancellation number: (877) 252-3229.

ANYONE IN VIOLATION of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

VOLUNTEER INFO

Historically, the Thanksgiving Agility Cluster Trials have been the largest AKC agility shows in the country! Running four rings simultaneously requires many volunteers.

We know that not everyone is available to help at trials. However, because of its size, our event requires many volunteers to keep the rings moving. If you could squeeze in a little time to volunteer for a class or two, it would be a huge help and very much appreciated.

All workers will receive worker tickets for each class worked.

AGAIN THIS YEAR, THE VOUCHERS CAN BE USED AS PAYMENT TO THE FOOD CONCESSION OR ANY VENDOR IN THE AGILITY BUILDING.

There will be multiple shifts of workers to cover the larger classes.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
