INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Purpose: The ISC class is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard and Jumpers courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course design is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent/Master classes. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website www.akc.org.

Eligibility: The event is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. Dogs may be entered in their Regular or Preferred jump height. However, there is no Preferred option for ISC; dogs entering in the Preferred jump height will be scored against their respective regular jump heights peers. Grade 3, 2, and 1 classes will be offered and available for entry for all competitors. Dogs may be entered in in any of the offered class levels and in multiple levels. (Grade 3 classes are the usual ISC Master level classes, Grade 2 is the Open, and Grade 1 is the Novice level ISC class.) FEO runs are allowed.

<u>Jump Heights</u>: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights. However, only those dogs running in the 12", 16", 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualification toward entering WTT or EOTT. Please see EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details. See jump height charts.

Qualifications: "Clean run" scores from ISC classes at the 12", 16", 20" and 24" may be used toward fulfilling the minimum requirements for *WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consist of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class. *As of January 2023, Grade 1 clean runs do NOT count toward WTT qualifiers, only Grade 2 and 3.

THIS IS NOT A REGIONAL WORLD TEAM QUALIFYING EVENT, MEANING THERE WILL NOT BE AN AUTOMATIC INVITE OF THE COMBINED WINNERS TO WTT.

Scoring: Time plus Faults. Faults and refusals are each 5 seconds penalties. Time penalty is 1 seconds for each second over course time. Faults are dropped bars, missed contacts. Wrong course is elimination. Three refusals are elimination. Eliminated teams cannot win or place. Examples: 2 faults (a bar and a contact) and 2 refusals = +20 seconds penalty. 4 faults = +20 seconds penalty. 3 refusals = elimination.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) - EFFECTIVE 7/1/24

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes at this trial. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es)
 prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary
 must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that
 class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will
 declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

<u>OBSTACLES</u>: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials as listed for ISC specifications.

ENTRY FEES: FOR ONLINE ENTRIES, GO TO <u>WWW.PAWPRINTTRIALS.COM</u>. FOR MAIL-IN ENTRIES, MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. **\$23.00** per class. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per run.

<u>CLOSING DATE</u>: Saturday, October 11, 2025 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

<u>WAIT LIST</u>: There will be a wait list (maximum 75 runs) to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial closes on Saturday, Oct. 11 at 6 p.m. Entries withdrawn BEFORE the trial closes will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn after trial closes on Oct. 11 at 6 p.m. but prior to Saturday, October 18 at 6 p.m., will be replaced with an entry from the waitlist if one is available. Any withdrawn entry replaced by an entry from the waitlist will receive a refund subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Saturday, October 18 at 6 p.m. will receive a refund.

<u>MOVEUPS & CANCELLATIONS</u>: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, refund requests for bitches in season will be accepted when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. Refund requests, along with the veterinarian's note, must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day. There will be no refund for injury or illness after entries close.

- THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.
- TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.
- **FOREIGN EXHIBITORS** must pay with an international money order or credit card. Checks drawn on banks outside the U.S. can no longer be accepted.
- NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

- BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".
- DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.
- **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE** will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss. injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom. sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running, If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
