MOVE UPS: As per Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *American Kennel Club Regulation for Agility Trials*, dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided the request is made in writing to the trial secretary no later than 6 p.m. on Monday, May 11, 2026. Move-ups will be accepted by mail or email, but not by phone or fax. Move-ups for the following day will be accepted at the trial site until the close of classes.

ENTERING FOR EXHIBITION ONLY (FEO) – Effective 7/1/24

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes at this trial. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may also be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

FIX AND GO ON (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

SITE INFO

No practicing in the rings is allowed at any time. **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES EXCEPT WHEN IN THE RING OR IN THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA.**

Dream Dogs Training Center is a 17,000 square foot state-of-the-art facility designed and built for dog events located in Saugerties NY. Fully climate controlled with ample parking for exhibitors and a large crating room connected to the arena. All new equipment is from Clip N Go, Max 200, and Mad Agility, with GrassTex "True Turf" as the running surface in an 80' x 120'

unobstructed ring. DDTC is committed to providing a safe and positive environment for dogs and their owners.

DIRECTIONS

From the South (NYC and New Jersey): I-87 North (NYS Thruway) to Saugerties Exit 20, then right onto Route 212 East, then right onto Kings Highway for 3 miles, then right onto Industrial Drive. Dream Dogs Training Center is on the left. Cars keep to the right when entering.

From the North (Albany and Western Massachusetts): I-87 South (NYS Thruway) to Saugerties Exit 20. Turn left onto Route 32 South, then turn left onto Route 212 East, then turn right onto Kings Highway. Follow for 3 miles, then turn right onto Industrial drive and follow to the end. Dream Dogs Training Center is on the left. Cars keep to the right when entering.

From the East: Take the Kingston Rhinecliff Bridge/Route 199 then exit onto Route 9W North for 4.5 miles then turn left onto Glasco Turnpike and follow over the RR tracks then turn right onto Kings Highway. Then prepare to quickly turn left onto Industrial Drive, follow to the end of the road. Dream Dogs Training Center is on the left. Cars must keep to the right when entering.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners/agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered. Dogs in the Preferred classes must jump their measured height. If you are unsure of your dog's height or your dog is borderline, and you don't have a height card, please enter the lower height. If necessary, the judge will move the dog up.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the *AKC Regulations for Agility Trials*.

ENTRY FEES: FOR ONLINE ENTRIES, GO TO WWW.PAWPRINTTRIALS.COM. FOR MAIL-IN ENTRIES, MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO PAWPRINT TRIALS. **\$20.00** for the first entry per dog each day; **\$20.00** for the second entry of the same dog each day; **\$20.00** for the third and fourth entries. Fees include AKC recording fee of \$4.50 per run.

CLOSING DATE: Saturday, May 2, 2026 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

WAITLIST: There will be a wait list (maximum 75 runs) to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial closes on Saturday, May 2 at 6 p.m. Entries withdrawn BEFORE the trial closes will receive a full refund. Entries withdrawn after the trial closes on May 2 at 6 p.m. but prior to Saturday, May 9 at 6 p.m., will be replaced with an entry from the waitlist if one is available. Any withdrawn entry replaced by a waitlist entry will receive a refund subject to a \$5.00 processing fee. Any waitlisted entry that does not move off the waitlist into the trial by Saturday, May 9 at 6 p.m. will receive a refund.

MOVEUPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. **If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.** No refunds/changes will be made without trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: After entries close, bitches in season will be eligible for a full refund when accompanied by a veterinarian's note. An administration fee of \$5.00 will be withheld. A 50% refund will be given for illness or injury to dogs or handlers. Illness/injury refund requests will also require a doctor or veterinary note. Refunds will not be issued without that documentation. All refund requests, along with medical documentation, must be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day.

TRIAL REGULATIONS -- NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

FOREIGN EXHIBITORS must pay with an international money order or credit card. Checks drawn on banks outside the U.S. can no longer be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules attached to the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refunds will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP), AKC Canine Partners Listing, or be approved FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. All American dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to All American dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

IN CASE OF CANCELLATION, please call AKC Event Cancellation number: (877) 252-3229.

ANYONE IN VIOLATION of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
